

Real example: how I filled the OBLPCT license verification printout

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Recreated from my own filing, redacted. Bracketed values are placeholders. Get the current blank form from the Mental Health Regulatory Agency license verification tool at <https://www.oregon.gov/mhra/pages/verify.aspx>.

What to notice

This is the primary-source verification that payers ask for, printed the day after the license was issued. It is not something you fill in; you look yourself up, print the result with the date on it, and attach it. Credentialing teams do the same lookup themselves, so the copy you send has to match the record on the day they check.

Two things on it matter more than they look. The first term after an initial license is short, because the expiration is tied to your birth month and the renewal cycle in the rule, so plan the first renewal early. And the languages line comes from your own licensee profile; PacificSource, CareOregon, and Providence each asked me the same language question again, and the answers should agree.
