

Real example: how I filled the MHACBO CADC continuing education log

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Recreated from my own filing, redacted. Bracketed values are placeholders. Get the current blank form from MHACBO (the renewal form downloads from the certification portal) at <https://www.mhacbo.org/en/>.

What to notice

Payer applications ask you to attest to continuing education, and the OPCA has a whole section for it, so the log you keep for the certification board is the log you will reuse. The form wants 40 clock hours per cycle with two minimums inside it: six hours of ethics and two of suicide prevention, and it caps general behavioral-health hours at twenty, so at least twenty must be alcohol-and-drug specific.

Most of my hours came in one December stretch three months before the March expiration. It worked, and I would not do it that way again: the certificates have to be attached one by one, and an employer's training transcript only counts for the courses that carry CE credit. Log each course the week you finish it.
