What to notice

The Medicaid panel application is the one form in this set that reads like a clinical interview: populations, modalities, outcome tools, crisis plan, and how you coordinate with a primary care provider. I signed it 06/03/2024 as a registered associate, so it also carried a supervision plan.

The free-text answers are what the reviewer reads. Mine are short and specific: the tools I use and what I do with the scores, what a crisis session looks like, how a referral to a prescriber happens. The demographics page is optional and I have left it blank in this example; the language and training pages are not optional, and the OHA training list has to be attested topic by topic.

The form asks for a telehealth care-coordination policy as an attachment. Mine is the CCO paragraph in the telehealth consent, shown in the telehealth lesson.

Approaches and modalities	Person-centered, integrated, with emphasis on ACT, DBT, and CBT; trauma-informed; EMDR and IFS as indicated
Outcome tools	Outcome Rating Scale for the client's own sense of progress; GAD-7 and PHQ-9 to track symptoms and adjust the plan
Crisis management	Assess risk, use a structured assessment when indicated, de-escalation and grounding, safety plan, refer to emergency services when appropriate; text and call support for clients in high distress
Coordination with primary care	Regular communication, shared treatment plans, care meetings when appropriate, referral and feedback loops so the PCP hears back promptly
Coordination for SUD	Eight years in the SUD field at that date (work history from 2016); open, non-judgmental interventions, relapse-prevention planning, MAT referrals, support groups, psychoeducation
